This User Guide is designed for both SIM cards inserted by selecting [Settings]—[Call Settings]—[Dual-SIM]—[Standby mode]—[Dual SIM (dual standby)].</p> <p><b>1.2 Insert memory card</b></p> <p>Remove the back cover and battery and turn over the cover of the memory card in the direction as shown thereon;</p> <p>Let the side of the memory card bearing metallic contact face down, insert the narrower end into the slot until absolutely fitted by it, and replace the back cover.</p> <p><b>Warning:</b> Please don't insert or remove the memory card quickly or frequently to avoid damage.</p> <p><b>1.3 Battery charging</b></p> <p>The phone battery may be charged with travel charger.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> 1. Please use the standard matched battery and charger to prevent explosion.</p> <p>2. Please use charger to charge this device. USB wire charging shall be avoided if possible.</p> <p><b>1.4 Power on and off</b></p> <p>Power on/off Long press power supply key for 3s to turn on/off this phone</p> <p><b>Warning:</b> Please don't turn on this phone where it is prohibited or using it may cause interference or danger. In this case, please ensure this phone does not activate the regular power on/off or other function.</p> <p><b>2. Call</b></p> <p><b>2.1 Making an overseas call.</b></p> <p>Enter the country code (in this case, "+" shall be entered by pressing * twice continuously); Enter the area code (without "0" prefixed to that as usual) and the phone number;</p> <p>Press "Call", escape the SIM card option screen. Select SIM1 to dial with SIM1; select SIM2 to dial with SIM2</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1</p>	<p><b>2.2 Dialing via Contacts</b></p> <p>Enter the Contacts and search for the phone number you need.</p> <p>Press Record for a long time to select Call in the option menu.</p> <p><b>2.3 Calling an extension number</b></p> <p>Enter the switchboard number;</p> <p>Press [Option]—[Insert]—[Pause] and then input the extension number;</p> <p><b>2.4 Making an emergency phone</b></p> <p>Enter the emergency phone number;</p> <p><b>2.5 Answer or reject incoming calls</b></p> <p>If there is an incoming call, press "Answer"/"Reject" to answer/reject it;</p> <p>For incoming calls under the lock situation, slide to left and right to answer or reject calls.</p> <p><b>2.6 Menu during a call</b></p> <p>During a call, you can:</p> <p><b>Hold:</b> Press [Hold] to hold current call, and press [Activate] to resume current call when holding the call (the function needs to be supported by network).</p> <p><b>Record:</b> Record the call details, and the document will be kept in the file manager automatically.</p> <p><b>Mute:</b> Turn off the microphone during the call. In the mute mode, you can hear the speaker but the speaker can't hear you.</p> <p><b>Turn on handsfree:</b> Start or cancel a handsfree call.</p> <p><b>2.7 Adjust volume</b> You can volume the receiver by side key during a call.</p> <p><b>2.8 End a call</b> Press "Hang up" to end a call.</p> <p><b>3. Message Service</b></p> <p><b>3.1 Write message</b></p> <p>Please have the service center number from the network operator before applying this function.</p> <p>The storage capacity of SIM card depends on its type.</p> <p><b>3.2 SMS</b></p> <p>Under idle situation, press "Information service" button to enter into the mailbox list interface, press [Write message]—[New SMS] to enter into the message editor interface; manual input or insert the contacts from the address list as the recipients, press "send" button to send the messages after editing the contents.</p> <p><b>4. Multimedia</b></p> <p><b>4.1 Camera</b></p> <p>Take pictures and videos clips with audio through the self-contained camera function.</p> <p>Click the camera icon from the main screen, and switch to the framing menu of the camera.</p> <p>Press return button to exit the camera procedure.</p> <p><b>Browse Shouted Photos or Videos</b></p> <p>Delete the photos or videos.</p> <p>Share through information and bluetooth.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2</p>	<p><b>4.2 DV</b></p> <p>Take pictures and video clips with audio through the self-contained camera function.</p> <p>Click the camera icon from the main screen, and switch to the framing menu of the camera.</p> <p>Press return button to exit the camera procedure.</p> <p>There are photo and video made in the device. The default mode is photo.</p> <p><b>Browse Shouted Photos or Videos</b></p> <p>Delete the photos or videos.</p> <p>Share through bluetooth.</p> <p><b>4.3 Audio</b></p> <p>The phone is able to play music files saved in phone and the downloaded music and support background play of MP3 file.</p> <p><b>Play songs:</b></p> <p>When play some certain contents, select the needed items from the list.</p> <p>Please press [ ] to pause; please press [▶] to continue; press [⏮] or [⏪] to fast forward or back. Please press [⏭] or [⏩] to turn to next or previous.</p> <p><b>4.4 Video</b></p> <p>The video player supports 3gp, mp4 and avi documents.</p> <p>If the document is the standard format not supported, use the tools to convert into the standard format.</p> <p><b>Play:</b> When play some certain contents, select the needed items from the list.</p> <p>Please press [ ] to pause; please press [▶] to continue; press [⏮] or [⏪] to fast forward or back. Please press [⏭] or [⏩] to turn to next or previous.</p> <p><b>Open: Open local browse, local list.</b></p> <p><b>Local browse:</b> Browse the video documents in the phone or memory card.</p> <p><b>Local list:</b> Play the stored video documents, you can add the videos in the memory card or the phone to local list for watching next time.</p> <p><b>4.5 FM Radio</b> The system will automatically scan channel is and record firstly open FM radio.</p> <p><b>Search Broadcast Channel</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Automatically search the broadcast channels, and press Options button → scan and save.</li> <li>Manually search the broadcast channels, and slide the roller on the screen (move the frequency red line to adjust) to slightly adjust, or manually input the channels.</li> </ul> <p><b>Background Play</b> Click Background play button, FM plays at background.</p> <p><b>Record</b> Record (scheduled record) the playing channels, and automatically save them to the record list.</p> <p><b>4.6 Recorder</b> Enter into the function menu to select the Recorder</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After stopping record, the recording documents will be automatically saved in the "Audio" file in the memory card, click Folder to check.</li> </ol> <p><b>4.7 Image</b></p> <p>Check the pictures and shouted photos in the memory card through the photo album.</p> <p><b>5. Settings</b></p> <p><b>5.1 Call settings</b></p> <p>Including: <b>Dual SIM settings:</b> including Standby mode, Reply by original SIM, Set SIM name.</p> <p><b>Call Divert:</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">3</p>	<p>◇ <b>Divert all voice calls:</b> After the function is activated, you can divert all incoming calls to Voicemail or the pre-determined phone numbers. Choose [Check Status] to view the current status of the Divert all voice calls service.</p> <p>◇ You have to turn off "Flight mode" before setting "Call divert".</p> <p><b>5.2 Call Waiting:</b></p> <p>◇ <b>Activate:</b> After the function is activated, the network will inform you of the new incoming calls when you are on a call. You can hold on the current call and answer another call.</p> <p><b>5.3 Call Barring:</b></p> <p>◇ <b>Outgoing calls:</b> All outgoing calls are limited</p> <p>◇ <b>Incoming calls:</b> All incoming calls are limited</p> <p>◇ <b>Hide My Caller ID:</b> Set the display mode of the phone number.</p> <p><b>Others:</b> the settings items include IP Push-To-Talk, Voice calls minute beep, Automatic redial, Vibration for outgoing calls, Message after rejecting, Voice broadcast for incoming calls.</p> <p><b>5.4 Phone Settings</b> The items include:</p> <p><b>Time and Date:</b> You can customize time and date as well as their formats</p> <p><b>Language:</b> You can customize the display language and writing language.</p> <p><b>Automatic Power On/Off:</b> Set time and repeat ways of the automatically power on/off.</p> <p>Restore <b>Factory Settings:</b> Restore factory settings</p> <p><b>5.5 Display Settings:</b> The settings items:</p> <p><b>Wallpaper Settings:</b> Supported wallpapers: Static wallpapers, dynamic wallpapers and more pictures. <b>Backlight:</b> adjust the screen backlight. <b>Button Backlight:</b> adjust the backlight time.</p> <p><b>5.6 Security settings</b> Including:</p> <p><b>PIN code:</b> Start and close of PIN code and the modification of PIN.</p> <p><b>Modify PIN2 code:</b> Modification of PIN2 code.</p> <p><b>Phone Lock:</b> Open or close the phone lock.</p> <p><b>Change Phone Password:</b> change the phone password.</p> <p><b>Privacy Protection:</b> set the privacy protection</p> <p><b>Automatic lock:</b> Set time of the automatic lock.</p> <p><b>Lock password:</b> Start or close the lock password.</p> <p><b>6. Phone profile</b></p> <p>The preset modes are Normal mode, Mute mode, Conference mode, Indoor mode, Outdoor mode, Handset mode, Bluetooth mode. It support custom profiles, define at most 5 profiles, and users can set the parameters of the profiles.</p> <p>Instruction: The preset profiles do not support delete, while the custom profiles support delete.</p> <p><b>7. Application</b></p> <p><b>7.1 Calculator</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select <b>Calculator</b> under function menu mode.</li> <li>Use the buttons matched with the calculator to carry out basic arithmetic operation.</li> </ol> <p><b>7.2 Alarm</b> Enter into the function list, then select <b>Alarm</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">4</p>

Internet</b></p> <p>Note:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Your internet service provider may not support some functions, please confirm that your SIM card supports Internet function and the function has been opened.</li> <li>To browse webpages, you might be charger of corresponding flow rate</li> <li>If WLAN network is applicable, surf the internet through WLAN interlinkage.</li> </ol> <p><b>8.1 Browser</b></p> <p>Open the starting page of the browser, users can enter into input URL, search, bookmarks, history and stored pages through the interfaces. Press Options button to open more menus, homepage, settings, clear records and exit browser homepage, and users can the homepage of ISP internet (set in advance or default homepage).</p> <p><b>9. Safety Information</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">6</p>	<p><b>9.1 Usage Environment</b></p> <p>To assure you use mobile phone reasonably and avoid its affect on you and environment, please keep in mind relevant regulations and provisions which shall be complied with at any place when you use mobile phone.</p> <p>Using mobile phone in plane may disturb plane's operation and give rise to danger. Therefore, please do turn off your mobile phone before boarding and make sure it is power off in the whole course of flight.</p> <p>When your drive, please place mobile phone on a special stand, do not place it on seat or any place where it may slide when it comes to collision or sudden braking. In the course of driving, please do not use mobile phone to assure a safe drive and avoid traffic accident. If you must use mobile phone, please stop first before using it.</p> <p>Please keep your mobile phone away from high-temperature environment to avoid bomb rising from increased temperature of battery.</p> <p><b>9.2 Emergency Call</b></p> <p>The same as other mobile phones, this kind of mobile phone uses radio signal, wireless and ground communication network and personal setting functions, it can't guarantee it can get linked successfully under any situations.</p> <p><b>9.3 Dial emergency call</b></p> <p>If your mobile phone is power off, please turn it on and check if network signal is strong enough.</p> <p><b>9.4 Password Access</b></p> <p>The mobile phone and SIM card can be protected by password to prevent them from illegal usage.</p> <p><b>9.5 Power-on Password</b></p> <p>To prevent your mobile phone from being used by others without your approval, you can set password when you use the function for the first time. After you use mobile phone, please change power-on password as soon as possible and keep it secret.</p> <p><b>9.6 PIN Code</b></p> <p>It is personal identification number to protect SIM card from being used by others without your approval. Usually PIN code and SIM card are provided together. When you use using power-on PIN code every time when you turn on mobile phone, you have to input password before starting the normal phone function.</p> <p><b>9.7 PIN2 Code</b></p> <p>PIN2 is password to realize special function of SIM card. If the network operation company provides this number to you, it is to be inputted for getting access to some functions (such as unit of account, fixed dial numbers, etc.). Usually PIN2 number and SIM card are provided together. If you input PIN2 code wrong three times successively, PIN2 code will be locked. You need to input PIN2 code to unlock it.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">7</p>	<p><b>9.8 PUK Code</b></p> <p>Unlock Key PIN code. Usually PUK code and SIM card are provided together. If you don't have, please contact your network operator or SIM card retailer. If you input wrong PUK code for ten times successively, SIM card can't be used any more. Then please apply to your network operator for a new card. Do not change PUK code.</p> <p><b>9.9 PUK2 Code</b></p> <p>Unlock PIN2 code. Usually PUK2 code and SIM card are provided together, PUK2 code can alter locked PIN2 code. If PUK2 number is inputted wrong for ten times successively, some functions can't be used any more. Then please apply to your network operator for a new card. Do not change PUK2 code. If it is lost, please contact service provider.</p> <p><b>Attentions on Charging of Battery</b></p> <p>This kind of mobile phone provides energy by lithium ion battery, system environment, mobile phone settings and others will affect waiting and conversation time of mobile phone.</p> <p>Please use the standard battery and charger provided by the company, or the company isn't responsible for damage caused by battery or charger unauthorized by the company.</p> <p>When the mobile phone is power on, the <b>batt</b> starts to roll on the battery indicator on the screen.</p> <p><b>Attentions on Use of Battery</b></p> <p>Please do not use damaged charged battery.</p> <p>Please do not place battery by mistaking its cathode and anode.</p> <p>Please do not place battery at place where it is too high or too low, or it will decrease battery's capacity and life. Please use battery at domestic temperature as possible as you can.</p> <p>Do not make battery short-circuit, or it will damage battery core or protective circuit inside battery. When you put unused battery in pocket or bag, medal items (coin, pin or pen, etc.) may link two ends of battery immediately and make battery short-circuit, so please place battery singly and safely.</p> <p>Please do not burn battery of mobile phone re do with it as common rubbish.
